They are looking for diverse, forward-thinking creative producers that are happy to dive into children's media culture, get to know like-minded producers and learn how their ideas can deliver something to today's generation of viewers.

Young Horizons Industry is an international co-production forum taking place from 30 September to 2 October 2024 in Warsaw, Poland and is part of the Young Horizons brand and Cinekid for Professionals is the professionals programme of Cinekid Festival, taking place at the end of October 2024 in Amsterdam, the Netherlands.

The Producer LINK programme creates space to inspire, network and empower creatives to make meaningful and relevant audiovisual content for a young audience.

Producers LINK will:

- Offer masterclasses, training, matchmaking; provide new insights, trends and audience information to emerging producers;
- Provide access to two major events and a consecutive programme specially tailored for the needs of the producers
- Stimulate the production of high quality children's content within Pan-European co-productions;

Details

The programme will start at Young Horizons Industry from 29.09. - 02.10.2024 and finish at Cinekid for Professionals from 29.10. - 01.11.2024. The programme will be held on-site in Warsaw and Amsterdam.

nordmedia will nominate a producer for the participation in the *Producers LINK* Programme according to the application. Eligible producers are emerging talents with at least 1 produced feature or series and at least 1 children's project in development.

nordmedia, Young Horizons Industry and Cinekid for Professionals cover the producer's participation in the programme, including accommodation. Costs for travelling to and from the programme locations are at the participants own expenses.
